

**The following conditions, equivalencies and recommendations have been identified by the two institutions participating in this Agreement.**

I Criteria for admission to Berkeley College and/or to the specific upper level program:

Completion of the AAS or AS degree as noted.  
Minimum grade point average of 2.0.

II Preferred program options:

AAS in Accounting (AAS.BUS.ACCTG) (Appendix A)  
Articulates with the BS degree in Business Administration, Accounting

AAS in Banking, Credit & Finance (AAS.BUS.BANK) (Appendix B)  
Articulates with the BS degree in Business Administration

AS in Business Administration (AS.PS.BUS.ADM) (Appendix C)  
Articulates with the BS degree in Fashion Marketing & Management

2. **Clarification of credit equivalents:** Berkeley College is on the “quarter-hour system”, while Bergen Community College is on the “semester-hour system”. One quarter hour of credit is earned for each 10-12 hours of scheduled class time at Berkeley. In essence, a three credit course completed at Bergen Community College will equate to a four credit course at Berkeley College.
3. Students who enter Berkeley College under the terms of this agreement, having earned the AS or AAS degrees noted, will receive credit for courses in which they have earned a grade of D.
