## *Certified Applicators Recertification Training*

**All courses are approved by the NJ Department of Environmental Protection for recertification units only. You must have an applicators license in order to receive recertification units.**

Pesticide applicators, food handlers, landscapers, home inspectors, dog groomers, and health department officials may choose any or all of the three-hour courses to meet their particular needs.
