

Installing Java Version 1.6 update 17

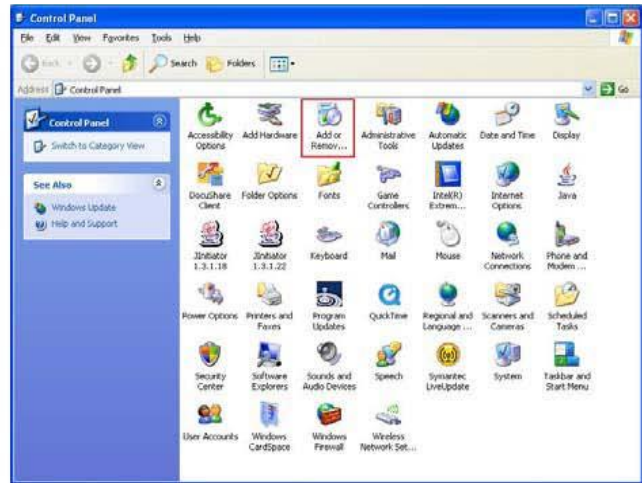

This document is divided into two parts:

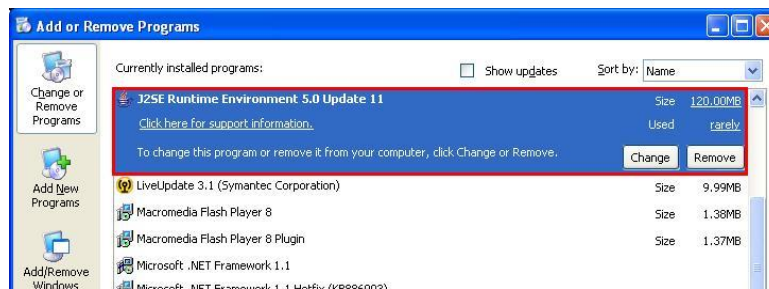
- Part 1 explains how to uninstall old versions of Java.

Uninstalling the current Java version for Windows XP

1. Click on Start
2. Choose Control Panel (or choose Settings and then Control Panel)
3. Once you are in Control Panel you will need to find the "Add/Remove Programs" option. Depending on how the folder options "view" is set it could look like one of the two following examples:



4. After opening the "Add or Remove Program" option you will be given another window that tells you to wait until the list is populated. Locate the one labeled "J2SE Runtime Environment X.0 Update X" - If the numbers you have in the place of X aren't Java Version 1.6 update 17, follow step 5-7.
5. Click on the title and you will see the option to either "Change" or "Remove"



6. If your screen shows ANYTHING OTHER than the Java Version 1.6 update 17, click on the "Remove" button.
7. After clicking on the "Remove" button you'll be prompted, "Are you sure you want to remove J2Se Runtime Environment X.0 Update X?" Choose "Yes"

After the program is uninstalled you may be prompted to reboot your computer, if not, restart your computer manually. After reboot you can install the correct version of Java.

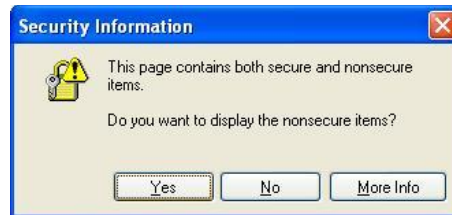

Installing " Java Version 1.6 update 17" for Windows XP

1. Open Internet Explorer. Click on Start and go to "All Programs." From there you should see the icon that represents Internet Explorer.

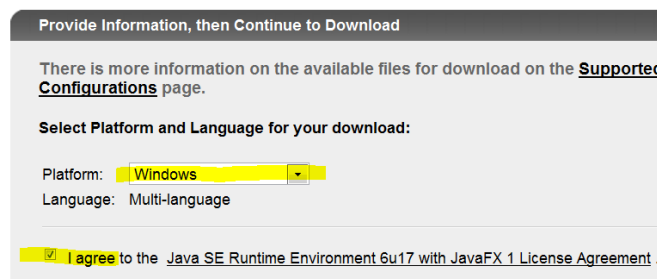


2. Once you have Internet Explorer opened type in the following address in the address bar: <http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/java/javase/index-138476.html> (or if you hold down CTRL and click the link here you will be directed to the site)
3. After you type the address into the address bar click on the "Enter" key on your keyboard.
4. Scroll down and click on the second available link, "Download JRE".
5. After choosing you **may be** prompted with the following, but all you need to do is click yes to continue onward.



6. Once you are past the prompt you will have another webpage. It is very important that you accept the license agreement. If you don't, you won't be able to proceed further.

7. Click on the box next to "I agree" and then scroll down the page and click on "Continue." If prompted again with the Security Information warning, click yes.

8. On the next page you will see a list of links that will allow you to download the different versions and options. Click on the title "Windows Offline Installation"

9. After you click on this option you will be asked to Run, Download or Cancel. Choose the "Run" option. This will download the file for installation.



10. The next pop-up will ask if you want to Run the program, Click on Run. The program will be installed.



11. After the installation has run you may be prompted to "Finish" simply click "Finish." Java will be updated.

No need to reboot the computer system. The proper version of the Java should be installed on your system.

Disable the JRE auto update

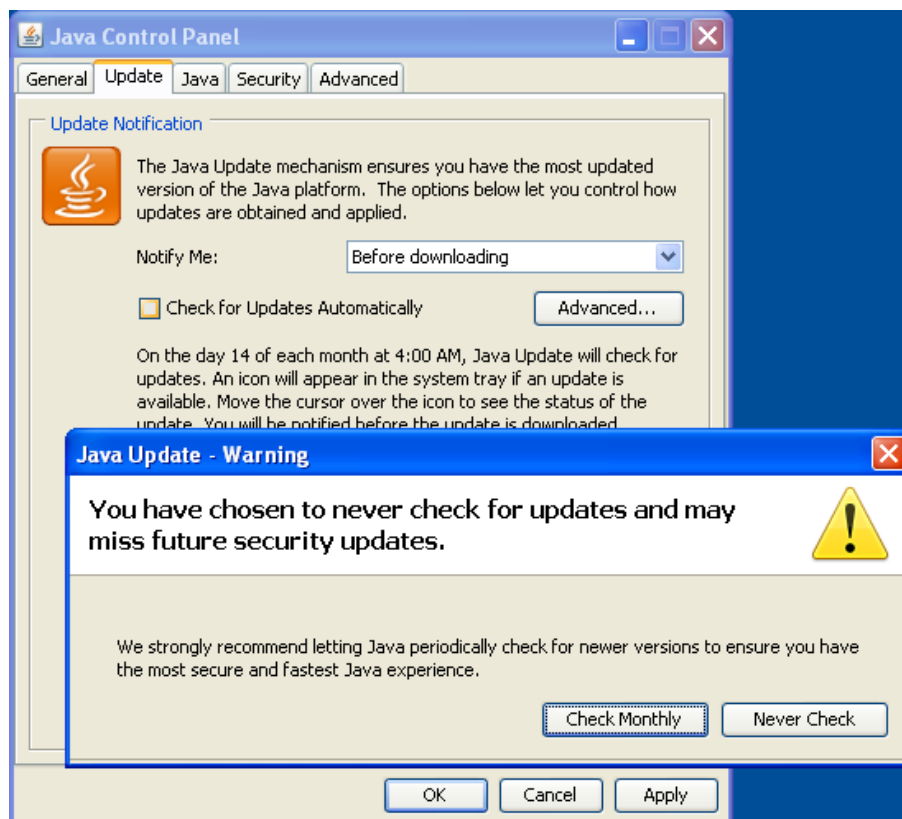
Please Note: Not all Java updates are compatible with WebCT courses. To keep Java from automatically changing your version you can follow the steps.

In Windows XP:

1. Click **Start**
2. Click **All Programs**
3. Click **Control Panel**
4. Click **Java** coffee cup icon



5. Click the **Update** tab
6. Deselect the check box for **Check for Updates Automatically**



7. At the warning sign click **Never Check**
8. Click **OK**
