Honors Articulation Agreement - November 12, 2008

Students who complete the requirements of the Bergen Community College Honors Program will be admitted to the Honors College at William Paterson University. These students will have met the Honors College's requirements for General Education, and will be eligible to enter into an Honors Track when they begin their studies at William Paterson University.

All students transferring into the Honors College at William Paterson University should contact the College's director so they can be placed in the right Honors Track. Students must complete a track application before they will be admitted into the Honors College.

An Honors Track is a set of courses designed to enhance a student's major. In order to complete a track and graduate from the Honors College, students must complete a final Honors project which is typically a research project or a creative project. Students receive extensive faculty mentoring as they progress through the tracks. Tracks function similarly to a minor, and are a distinctive set of courses that enhance a student's academic career. Students select one of the eight tracks based on their major, academic goals, and personal interests. (See <http://www.wpunj.edu/icip/honors/curriculum.htm>.)

As Honors students, transfer students are eligible to live in the Honors residential community and participate in the cultural, service, and social events sponsored by the Honors College.

Transfer students who enter the Honors College are awarded a scholarship of \$2000 per year, which is available to them for two years if they meet the requirements of the Honors College.

Bergen Honors students applying for admission to the WPU Honors College will have their application fee waived.
