From the North:

(Via Garden State Parkway)-Take Exit 165, turn right (west) on Ridgewood Rd., then right onto Ridgewood Ave. (crossing over Route 17) and continue to Paramus Rd. Turn left onto Paramus Rd. and continue approx. 2 miles to College; proceed around jug handle to main entrance.

(Via Route 17)-Turn right off Route 17 onto Ridgewood Ave. (west) to Paramus Rd. Turn left onto Paramus Rd. and continue as above.

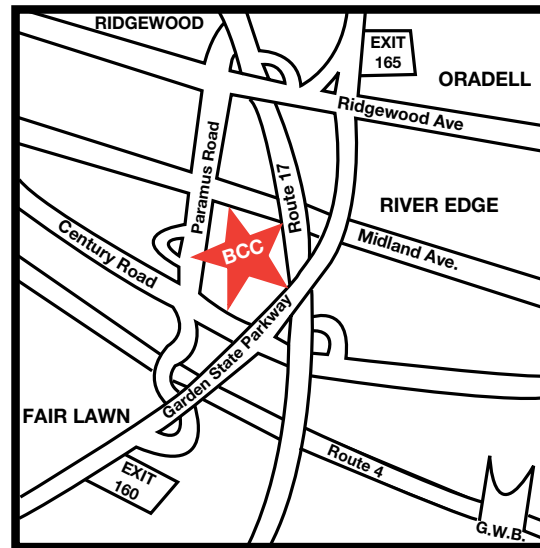
From the East:

Take Route 4 (via George Washington Bridge from New York City) to Paramus Rd., Paramus. (From the east, Paramus Rd. is approx. ¼ mile past Route 17 intersection). Turn right onto Paramus Rd. and proceed north for approx. 2 miles to College entrance on right side of Paramus Rd.

From the South:

(Via Garden State Parkway)-Take Exit 160 (Passaic St.). Turn left onto Passaic St. Continue over Route 4 onto Paramus Rd. (Passaic St. becomes Paramus Rd. north of Route 4 overpass). Continue north about 2 miles on Paramus Rd. to College entrance on right.

(Via Route 17)-Take Century Rd., 2nd exit to the right; proceed around clover leaf over Route 17 onto Century Rd. (west). Continue to Paramus Rd. and turn right onto Paramus Rd. to College entrance on right.



From the West:

Take Route 4 to Paramus Rd., Paramus (exit under overpass). Turn right onto Paramus Rd. and proceed north for approx. 2 miles to College entrance on right side of Paramus Rd.

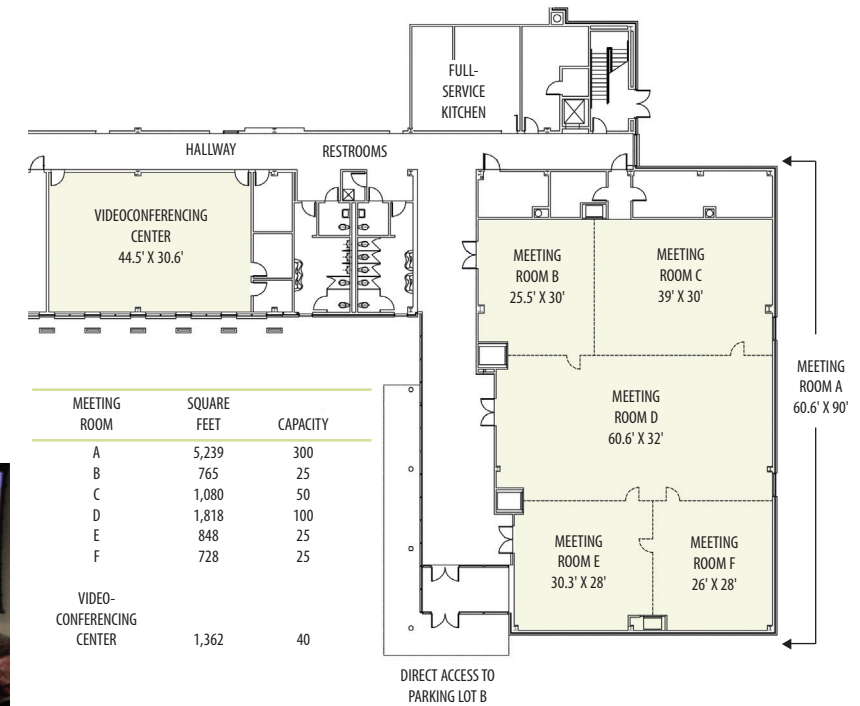

Location:

The Technology Education Center (TEC) is located next to the Pitkin Education Center. The Pitkin Education Center is the largest building you see directly ahead when entering the campus from Paramus Road. Bear right and follow the signs to Parking Lot B. Make a left turn into Lot B. As you come half-way around Parking Lot B, the TEC building is clearly visible on your left; it has a two-story glass front and two observatories visible from the roof. There are two entrances to TEC: the main entrance facing the Pitkin Center, and the side entrance facing Lot B, which is immediately adjacent to the Meeting and Training Center (TEC-128).

Room Layouts and Specifications

Our flexible meeting space can comfortably seat 300 people and can easily be converted from one large room to up to five smaller rooms or combinations of two or three, accommodating between 25 and 100 people.
