- ALL ESSAYS MUST BE TYPED, DOUBLE SPACED AND HAVE A TITLE PAGE. THE STUDENT'S NAME, ADDRESS, WORK AND HOME/CELL TELEPHONE NUMBERS, AND STUDENT ID# MUST APPEAR ON THE TITLE PAGE ONLY, not on each page of the essay.
- EACH STUDENT SUBMITTING AN ESSAY MUST PERSONALLY HAND DELIVER THE ESSAY TO THE BCC FOUNDATION OFFICE AND SIGN AN ESSAY CONTEST RELEASE FORM IN ORDER TO ENTER.

### DEADLINE!

- ALL ESSAYS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2010 AT 4:30 PM.
- REMEMBER: TO BE CONSIDERED, YOU MUST HAND DELIVER YOUR ESSAY TO THE BCC FOUNDATION OFFICE IN SCOSKIE HALL AND SIGN A RELEASE FORM ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE.

- THE TOP CONTEST WINNER WILL BE INTRODUCED AT THE MEDALLION AWARDS DINNER ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2010.
- CONTEST WINNERS MUST BE DULY ENROLLED AND IN GOOD STANDING AT BCC AND MUST MEET ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT.
- DUE TO GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS, ONLY U.S. CITIZENS AND U.S. PERMANENT RESIDENTS WITH A PERMANENT RESIDENT CARD (I-551 OR I-551C) ARE ELIGIBLE.
- THE SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE ISSUED IN THE FORM OF CREDITS FOR TUITION, FEES AND BOOKS UP TO THE MAXIMUM OF THE AWARD PAYABLE OVER TWO SEMESTERS OF STUDY AT BCC.
