The final categories will be determined based on the actual submissions. Readers will select the best papers for inclusion in the Program. The criteria of selection are:

- *Clarity and effectiveness of ideas presented*
- *Originality*
- *Evidence of research (including proper citations)*
- *An analytical approach*

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The paper should be typed, double-spaced on 8 ½" x 11" white paper with left-hand margin of 1 ½ " and at least 1" top, bottom and right, and pages must be numbered with Arabic numerals in the upper right-hand corner.
- The cover sheet should include student's full name, address, phone number and e-mail. *The name of the student must not appear anywhere other than on the title page.*
- The paper should be 7-12 pages in length, excluding the bibliography. Presenters will have a total of twenty minutes each to deliver the paper, including a media presentation, if applicable.
- **E-mail the paper as a Word or rtf file to Patrice Lenowitz, plenowitz@bergen.edu by March 9, 2012, 5PM.** (In the subject line, please write "Student Conference submission.") **OR** hand deliver it to the Honors Office, A-336.
- ALL current Bergen students are eligible to submit their work, including this year's graduates. All students will be notified of the status of their submission promptly after the March 9th deadline.
