### Here are some answers to frequently asked questions about credit allocation for the BSN for BCC students and graduates

The published/posted INFORMATION PACKET (on BCC nursing webpage) shows that **125 credits** are required for the BSN degree. Review the two grids in the INFORMATION PACKET.

- You will receive **30 credits** for the following general education courses that you completed as part of the AAS degree requirements

WRT 101 and WRT 201 – College Composition	- 6 credits
PSY 100 – Intro to Psychology	- 3 credits
PSY 106 - Life Span Developmental Psychology	- 3 credits
SOC 101- Intro to Sociology	- 3 credits
BIO 109 and BIO 209 - A & P I and II	- 8 credits
BIO 104 – Microbiology	- 4 credits
WEX 101 and Experience – Health & Fitness	- 3 credits

- You will receive **30 credits** for the nursing courses that you completed as part of the AAS degree
- The BSN degree requires an additional **28 general education** credits as follows (you may already have some of these)

INF 101-Intro to Info Technology	- 3 credits
COM 111- Speech Communication	- 3 credits
PHI 101-Intro to Philosophy	- 3 credits
MAT 150-Elementary Statistics	- 3 credits
SOC 103 -Sociology of the Family	- 3 credits
LITERATURE – World Literature	- 3 credits (from courses noted on grid)
HUMANITIES	- 3 credits (from courses noted on grid)
HISTORY -American Civilization	- 3 credits (from courses noted on grid)
CHM 112 – College Chemistry	- 4 credits
