Sale Dates: **Wednesday, September 17, Thursday, September 18, and Friday, September 19**

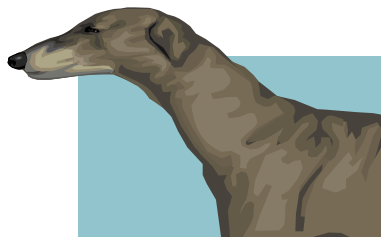
