Bergen Men's Track & Field Team Shines at National Championships

Congratulations to the Bergen Men's Track & Field Team for their fifth place finish at the 2008 NJCAA Div. III Outdoor Track & Field Championships, hosted by SUNY-Delhi May 8-10. Ricardo Garcia, of Union City, was the individual champion (and First Team NJCAA Div. III All-American) in the 400 meter hurdles. Teammates Kwame Banahene and Mark Edwards, of Hackensack, Harold Blyden, of Bergenfield, and Derval Thomas, of Paterson, won the 4-x-100 Relay and also earned First Team All-American honors. Second Team All-American honors were awarded to Derval Thomas in the 100 and 200 meter races and to Harold Blyden in the triple jump. Special congratulations to Head Coach Randy Brazil for being named NJCAA Div. III Track & Field Coach of the Year.

Faculty Accomplishments/Highlights

Prof. Susanna Lansangan (English Department) performed at the 2008 Filipino (Pinoy) Music Festival and Expo de Mayo at the Meadowlands Expo Center in Secaucus, New Jersey, on May 17, 2008. She sang with "It's Simply Green," a band featuring performers from alumni associations of Philippine universities. The event, a celebration of Filipino music, was an entertainment extravaganza in the East Coast and also featured top celebrities and performers from the Philippines. The Expo de Mayo honored the Filipinos' Spanish heritage through music and exhibits.

On May 4-7, Annemarie Roscello, Reference Librarian in the Sidney Silverman Library, attended the New Jersey Academy of Library Leadership in Long Branch, New Jersey. This Academy facilitates communication across different types of libraries: public, school and academic, to develop quantitative strategies to keep libraries at the forefront of innovation. The participants then take ideas for the development of 21st century skills back to their home institutions, which can be applied to patrons and library employees.
