Faculty Accomplishments/Highlights

On June 8, 2008, Lori Michael, ESL Teacher, participated in the American Cancer Society's 21st Annual George Washington Bridge Challenge. Participants from all over the tri-state area took part in either walking, running, or biking across the lower level of the most traveled bridge in the region. Over 70 teams and more than 500 people gathered together for this worthy cause. Ms. Michael did a 5K walk in memory of her mother Beverly Michael, wife of Oscar Michael (Inventory Control dept.), who lost her battle with Ovarian Cancer back in August 2003.

Professors Ken Bonnaffons and Heidi Lieb, of the Arts & Communications department, took a BEST Plus Test Administrator Training class, and were awarded a certificate of professional development on May 19, 2008. The course will enable them to measure English proficiency levels from beginning ESL literary to highly advanced, in the National Reporting System (NRS).

The STAR Club was presented with a plaque from the Muscular Dystrophy Association in recognition of raising \$1,319 over the last two years. This money will give assistance to children affected by one of over 43 neuromuscular disorders. The plaque was designed by children who have Muscular Dystrophy.
