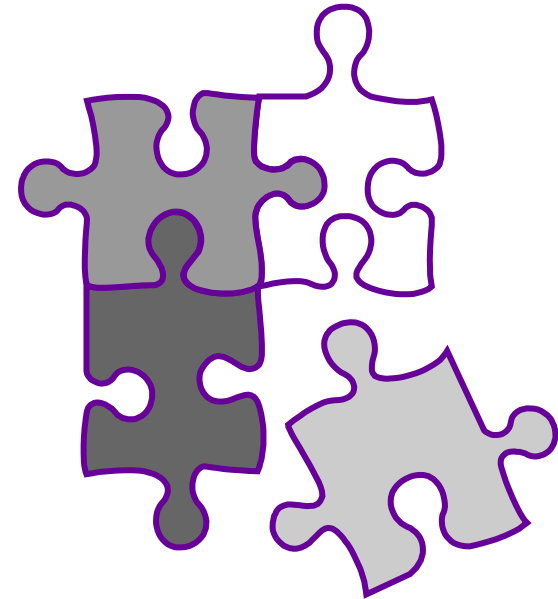

With an Editor	Starke, Linda, ed. <i>State of the World 2009: Into a Warming World</i> . New York: W.W. Norton, 2009. Print.

<b>E-Book</b>	Author Last Name, First. <i>Title of Book</i> . Publisher location: Publisher name, Publication year. Publication medium. <i>Database name</i> . Publication medium. Day month year accessed.
Example:	Ain, Kenneth B. and M. Sara Rosenthal. <i>The Complete Thyroid Book</i> . New York: McGraw-Hill, 2005. <i>NetLibrary</i> . Web. 21 July 2009.

<b>Article from a Book</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Article Title." <i>Title of Book</i> . Editor of Book. Edition of Book. Publisher location: Publisher name, Publication year. Pages. Publication medium.
Example: Work in an Anthology	O'Connor, Flannery. "Good Country People." <i>The Compact Bedford Introduction to Literature</i> . Ed. Michael Meyer. 8th ed. New York: Bedford/St. Martin's, 2009. 378-92. Print.
Example: Article in an Encyclopedia	Plank, Steven. "Hildegard of Bingen." <i>Women in World History: A Biographical Encyclopedia</i> . Ed. Anne Commire. Vol. 7. Waterford, CT: Yorkin Publications, 1999. Print.

<b>Journal Article Reprinted in a Book</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Article Title." <i>Publication Title</i> Volume number.Issue number (Publication year): Pages. Rpt. in <i>Title of Book</i> . Editor of Book. Volume number. Publisher location: Publisher name, Publication year. Pages. Publication medium.
Example:	Bosco, Mark. "Consenting to Love: Autobiographical Roots of 'Good Country People.'" <i>Southern Review</i> 41.2 (2005): 283-295. Rpt. in <i>Short Story Criticism</i> . Ed. Jelanna Krstovic. Vol. 111. Detroit: Gale, 2008. Print.

<b>Article from a Newspaper or Magazine</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Title of Article." <i>Publication Title</i> Publication day month year: Pages. Publication medium.
Example: Newspaper Article	Chang, Kenneth. "Is the Sun Missing its Spots?" <i>New York Times</i> 21 July 2009, late ed.: D1+. Print.

<b>Article from a Journal</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Title of Article." <i>Publication Title</i> Volume number.Issue number (Publication year): Pages. Publication medium.
Example:	Honeybee Genome Sequencing Consortium. "Insights into Social Insects from the Genome of the Honeybee <i>Apis Mellifera</i> ." <i>Nature</i> 443.7114 (2009): 931-49. Print.

<b>Newspaper or Magazine Article in a Database</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Title of Article." <i>Publication Title</i> Publication day month year: Pages. <i>Database name</i> . Publication medium. Day month year accessed.
Example: Magazine Article in a Database	Ramirez, Eddy. "The Crash Course in Citizenship; A New Front Line in the Immigration Debate: Access to Higher Education." <i>U.S. News &amp; World Report</i> 18 August 2008: 46. <i>General OneFile</i> . Web. 28 July 2009.
Example: with no Author	"What to Read Now and Why." <i>Newsweek</i> . 13 July 2009: N.pag. <i>ProQuest</i> . Web. 27 August 2009.

<b>Journal Article from a Database</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Title of Article." <i>Publication Title</i> Volume number.Issue number (Publication month year): Pages. <i>Database name</i> . Publication medium. Day month year accessed.
Example:	Jenvey, Vikii B. "The Relationship between Television Viewing and Obesity in Young Children: A Review of Existing Explanations." <i>Early Child Development &amp; Care</i> 177.8 (2007): 809-20. <i>Academic Search Premier</i> . Web. 27 July 2009.

<b>Article in a Database Reprinted from a Book</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Article Title." <i>Title of Book</i> . Editor of Book. Publisher Location: Publisher name, Publication year. Pages. <i>Database name</i> . Publication medium. Day month year accessed.
Example:	Johns, Sally. "Tennessee Williams." <i>Twentieth-Century American Dramatists</i> . Ed. John MacNicholas. Detroit: Gale Research, 1981. N.pag. <i>Literature Resource Center</i> . Web. 28 July 2009. Dictionary of Literary Biography 7.



**NOTE:**

For articles use:

- Complete page range for continuous pages;
- First page and '+' for non-continuous pages;
- 'N.pag.' when no page numbers given.

<b>Article in an Online Encyclopedia</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Article Title." <i>Title of Encyclopedia</i> Publisher name, Publication year. Publication medium. Day month year accessed.
Example:	Selin, Noel Eckley. "Wind Power." <i>Encyclopaedia Britannica Online</i> . Encyclopaedia Britannica, 2009. Web. 27 July 2009.

<b>Article within a Web Site</b>	Article Author Last Name, First. "Article Title." <i>Title of Website</i> . Publisher or sponsor of website. Day month year of publication. Publication medium. Day month year accessed.
Example:	"Rural Americans and the Unemployed Struggle to Get Adequate Health Insurance." <i>KHN Kaiser Health News</i> . The Henry J. Kaiser Family Foundation. 23 July 2009. Web. 28 July 2009.



**NOTE:** All citations should be formatted with a 1/2" hanging indent, double-spaced, and alphabetized by the first word, usually the author's last name. If no author name is given, alphabetize by the first word in the title.
