Barbara Walcott is the Library's liaison to Nursing, but any member of the Library staff will be glad to help you. Just ask!

Books

Use **Find Books** on the Library home page to locate books and videos. A BCC student ID is required to borrow from the Library. The Library keeps a copy of most textbooks used at BCC in a Reserve collection behind the Service Desk. They are for use in the Library only.

STAT!Ref is a small collection of electronic books in nursing and medicine. The books will appear in the Library catalog, but the collection may also be searched. Go to "**Full List of Databases**" on the Library's home page and select STAT!Ref.

Videos

Videos are available in the Library's Media Services department. Many must be used in the Library. A few are also accessible in WebCT, the course management system used at BCC.

A series of videos (and related material) on nursing skills is available online through Delmar, a publisher. To access these videos you must first register at www.delmar.com and add the Learning Code which will be given to you.

Journals

The Library subscribes to many nursing journals in print/paper format, but provides access to many more online through databases. Journals the Library subscribes to in either format are listed in the "**Journal Titles List**," accessible from a link on the left side of the Library home page. Articles from journals the Library does not own may be obtained through InterLibrary Loan.

CINAHL

The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature is the best database for nursing journal articles. Access it from the Library home page under **Find Articles** and **Full List of Databases**. (If you are off campus you will be asked for your last name and 7 digit Bergen ID number.)

Search by combining keywords using "and" (eg. lyme disease **and** treatment). There may be links to full text articles which can be printed and e-mailed, but sometimes only the citation and abstract (summary) are available in the database.

A short **tutorial** on searching the CINAHL database can be accessed from the Library home page. Go to the navigation bar on the left side of the page and select **Research Tutorial**. On the "Sidney" screen, click Return User, Advanced Searching and then select Nursing and Allied Health.
